More details about this Sunday's Wholeness and Healing Service are overleaf. I am excited about the year ahead for us at St Luke's, with lots coming up. Next Sunday (11th February) we'll be asking you to complete a short questionnaire, seeking your thoughts and feedback on our worship services. At the end of February Anna, Rachel and myself are off to the New Wine Leadership Conference, with the theme 'Holy, Healthy & Humble'. In May we are planning a PCC away day when we will take time to pray, reflect, and discern how God is leading us forward. In the summer, we have plans to take some of our young people to Spree SW (a Christian youth weekend in Devon) and to take a group to New Wine at Shepton Mallet (more details to follow). However, there is a cost to sustaining and growing the mission and ministry of St Luke's, and our financial situation is challenging, so on Sundays later in February we'll be thinking about our stewardship of all that God has given us. This will culminate in gift days on 2rd and 3rd March, giving us an opportunity to respond to God's generosity to us, to support and be part of God's work at St Luke's.
