Dear St Luke's family,

In our gospel reading for this Sunday, Jesus encounters a man who was deaf and could barely talk. Jesus ministers to him, speaking the words, "Be opened!" He can bring wholeness and healing to our lives when we bring our needs to him. This Sunday at our wholeness and healing service, we'll invite the congregation to come forward (as usual) to take communion and then (if you wish) to go into the chancel where a prayer team will be ready to pray with you. This is for the whole church family, and it is especially good to pray for children as well as adults. There is a wonderful line in our opening hymn which is very much our theme for this service: "Strength for today and bright hope for tomorrow."
