Update on church finances

We are considering options to reduce costs. Apart from parish share, our largest cost is staff salaries, and we may need to make savings in this area if nothing changes. To avoid this, our income from regular giving needs to increase. Our deficit is such that we need an average of around £30 extra per church member per month.
