The Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill, which would legalize assisted dying in England and Wales, is to be debated and voted on in the House of Commons on 29<sup>th</sup> November. However, the bill would need to go through further debates and votes before becoming law. You may wish to contact your MP about this.
