This week we are praying for HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY - 27th January - The 79th Anniversary of the Liberation of Auschwitz — Birkenau "Your brother's blood is crying out to Me from the ground..." (Genesis 4:10-11)

Our Father in Heaven, You heard the cries of the six million Jewish men, women and children who were murdered so brutally in the Holocaust simply because they were Jewish. You know the names of every mother, father, brother, sister, daughter and son who suffered such horrific premeditated cruelty. Forgive us, where, with the same indifference that was shown over 79 years ago, we have allowed anti-Semitism to again rear its ugly head. We pray for the families and friends who grieve the savage murder (less than four months ago) of 1,200 Jewish men, women and children - young and old: the most appalling atrocity since the Holocaust. Father, only You can change hearts filled

with such hatred and violence towards Jewish people. May we honour the memory of Holocaust victims and those killed on October 7th, through our prayers, love and support for Your people. Please overshadow and deliver the hostages held in nightmarish conditions. Comfort their anguished families and friends. Bring the deliverance, restoration and peace that can only be found through salvation in Jesus (Yeshua). Thank You Sovereign God. In the Name of our Messiah - the Lord Jesus. Amen.
